Open House or Meet the Teacher Night will look different this year. Here are ways your child's teacher may connect with families:



School Cash Online- District News

As you know we have made several modifications to how we operate in order to mitigate the risk of COVID-19. We want to assure you that the health and safety of your family and our staff is our high priority.

As part of those modifications, we are asking you to use our new online system to complete permission forms etc. and as a payment system (School Cash Online) to purchase school items when you can. Cash can play a significant role in virus transmission, and we are working toward following the World Health Organization (WHO) recommendations to use contactless payments to mitigate virus spread. Paying school fees and signing school forms online is fast and easy and can be done from any computer or smartphone.

Get setup in three simple steps:

- 1. **Create Your Profile:** Go to https://nlps.schoolcashonline.com and click on "Register" and fill in all appropriate fields.
- 2. **Confirm Your Email:** Check your inbox for the email confirmation and click on the link inside.
- 3. Sign in with your new login details.
- 4. Add a Student: Click "Add Student" and fill in the required fields with your child's details.
